

H&R MFRC VACATION LOTTERY EXTRAVAGANZA JANUARY 2016 – MARCH 2017 HOUSE TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

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1) Ticket sales for the lottery start Thursday, January 7, 2016 and will be available until sell out or March 10, 2017. The lottery has 71 prizes in total.

2) A Maximum of 1,500 tickets will be sold. Odds are 1 in 21.

3) Every ticket sold enters the buyer in 5 draws a month from April 2016 to March 2017. Monthly draws include: vacation gift card valued at \$4,500 and \$500 spending money or \$3600 cash, a \$1000 cash prize, a \$500 cash prize and 2 monthly bonus prizes valued at \$150 (Superstore Gift Cards).

4) 5 early bird draws at 10:00am Friday, February 19, 2016: each prize valued at \$100.00

5) 5 early bird draws at 10:00am Friday, March 11, 2016: each prize valued at \$100.00

6) 1 grand early bird travel draw at 10:00am Friday, March 23, 2016: prize valued at \$4,500.00 plus \$500 spending money.

7) Winners of early birds, monthly cash and monthly bonus prizes are re-entered for subsequent draws. When an individual wins the monthly grand prize (vacation) their name is withdrawn from subsequent draws.

8) Monthly draws will be held on the 10th day of each month at 10:00 am, unless that day falls on a weekend or holiday, in which case the draw will take place on the next week day. Unless otherwise specified, draws will take place at the MFRC Shearwater site (Bldg. 14, Shearwater, NS BOJ 3A0) 30 Provider Road, Shearwater, NS BOJ 3A0)

9) Draws are open to the public and ticket holders are welcome to attend. Ticket holders are not permitted to draw for prizes.

10) Winners will be contacted directly. Winner's names will also be posted to www.halifaxmfrfc.ca or by calling 902-427-7084

11) All grand prize winners will be required to have a photo taken for MFRC promotional purposes.

12) If the MFRC is closed on a draw day due to unforeseen circumstances, an alternate date will be communicated via the MFRC Vacation Lottery Extravaganza website or by calling the MFRC at 902-427-7788.

13) Tickets are secured in a locked box at the Shearwater MFRC site.

14) Regular Force Military members can purchase tickets through payroll deduction, at a cost of \$10 a month for a period of 12 months, starting in April 2016.

DND civilians and members of the general public can opt to pay for tickets through Automatic Bank Withdrawal at the cost of \$10 a month for a period of 12 months, starting April 1, 2016. A void cheque must be supplied. They can also pay by cash, credit card debit or personal cheque (no post-dated) for the full amount of \$120.

15) Attempts to contact winners will be made immediately following the draws. Names of winners will be released immediately. Once a person has been contacted they have 90 days to claim their prize. If a prize goes unclaimed after 90 days, a new draw will be held for that prize.

16) Ticket buyers are required to provide contact information, phone number(s), email addresses and physical address for the purposes of contacting winners.

17) It is the responsibility of ticket buyers to report changes in contact information to the H&R MFRC at 902-427-7084.

18) If a ticket buyer cancels an allotment and/or automatic bank withdrawal, they will be invoiced for the remaining cost of the ticket and will be removed from all draws until full payment is made. It is the responsibility of the ticket buyer to communicate to the MFRC if they release early or unexpectedly, or retire before the payment scheduled is completed. The member must be in good standing to claim a prize.

19) Vacation winners have the option of taking \$3600 cash, which is approximately 80% of the value of the average trip drawn. The \$500 spending money will be forfeited if the cash option is chosen. Winners have 20 days from prize notification to decide on the cash vs. trip gift card/spending money option.

20) Winners will be asked to show photo identification before claiming their prize.

21) Tickets cannot be purchased prior to January 7, 2016 at 9:00am or after March 10, 2017 at 4:00pm.

22) To be guaranteed to be in the upcoming early bird draws, ticket orders must be submitted at least 3 days prior to the date of each early bird draw.

24) Tickets will be sold on a first-come, first-served basis.

25) All tickets must be purchased in the province of NS. Purchasers can be, for example, from NB and purchase tickets, but they must be physically in Nova Scotia at the time of purchase.
